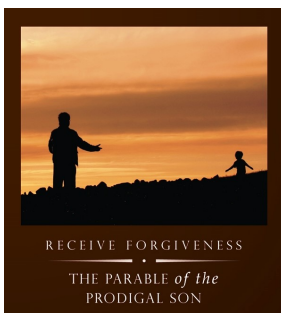
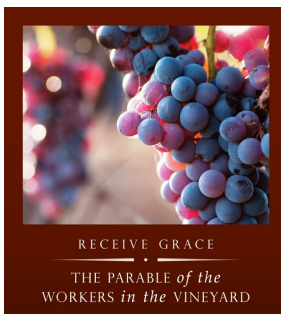
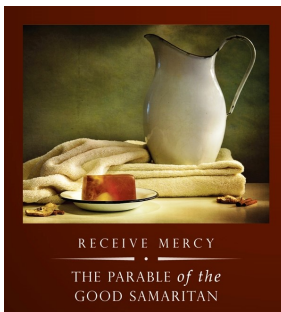
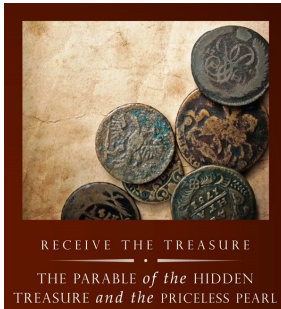
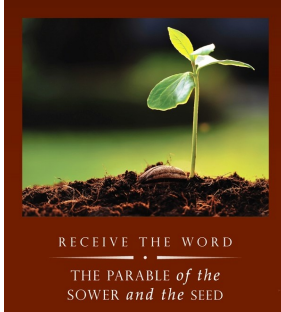
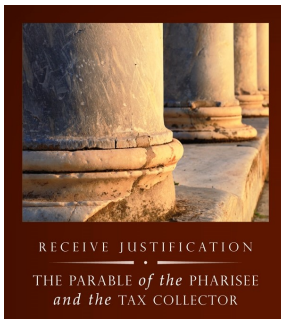


Join Immanuel Lutheran Church and University Student Center For Lenten Celebrations



Join us at Immanuel for *The Parables of Lent*, a special series of services for the season of Lent. Each service in this series focuses on a biblical parable that connects to Lenten themes. The Ash Wednesday service in the series is based on the parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector. In this parable, the tax collector who repents goes home justified, while the proud Pharisee does not. The parable reminds us that we, too, who repent are justified through Christ. The service includes the Imposition of Ashes.
